

**The City of Kurten**  
**City Council Meeting Minutes**  
**February 23, 2010**

**Regular City Council Meeting**

1. Mayor Vitulli called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. Aldermen Lindahl, Estes, Bouse, Adams, and Klintworth were present.
2. Citizen's Comments: Council members discussed Zajicek family situation.
3. January 26, 2010 City Council minutes were reviewed. Motion by Alderman Estes to approve minutes. Alderman Adams seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
4. January financial report was reviewed. Motion by Alderman Bouse to approve financial report. Alderman Klintworth seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
5. Consider and take action on the following bills:

  - a. Mr. Catalena responded to Mayor Vitulli's follow-up letter and indicated he would take care of the situation after the commissioner election.
9. Discuss and take action on City of Kurten sales tax.
  - a. Mayor Vitulli is working with Mary Lynn Stratta, Secretary of the City of Bryan, to have an item on the May 2010 election for citizens of Kurten to vote for a sales tax.
  - b. The City of Kurten City Council cannot promote voting for a sales tax for the City, but the residents can.
  - c. Mayor Vitulli would like to send a letter to city residents explaining what the council is doing regarding a sales tax and other news.
  - d. Residents residing North of Hwy. 21 will vote at Zion church. Residents residing South of Hwy. 21 will vote at the Reliance Community Center.
