City Council Meeting Minutes
March 23, 2010

Regular City Council Meeting

1. Mayor Vitulli called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. Aldermen Lindahl, Estes, Bouse, Adams, and Klintworth were present. Joe Trowbridge also present.
2. Citizen's Comments: Mr. Trowbridge is pleased with roadwork, but indicates more ditch scraping needs to be done.
3. February 23, 2010 City Council minutes were reviewed. Motion by Alderman Lindahl to approve minutes. Alderman Adams seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
4. February financial report was reviewed. Motion by Alderman Bouse to approve financial report. Alderman Klintworth seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
5. Consider and take action on the following bills:

 - a. Mayor Vitulli has not talked to Mr. Catalena since the commissioner election. He will contact Mr. Catalena again.
9. Discuss and take action on City of Kurten sales tax.
 - a. City of Kurten sales tax proposition will be on the ballot on the May 8, 2010 election.
 - b. Early voting will take place at Bryan City Hall.
 - c. Mayor Vitulli drafted letter to Kurten residents explaining what the council is doing regarding a sales tax and other news.
10. Ordinance #35, Canceling the General Election for May 8, 2010, was adopted.
11. Discussion of future agenda items. No new agenda items.
