City Council Meeting Minutes
April 27, 2010

Regular City Council Meeting

1. Mayor Vitulli called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. Aldermen Estes, Bouse, Adams, and Klintworth were present. Joe Trowbridge also present.
2. Citizen's Comments: Alderman Estes visited new neighbor and inquired if he needed information from City of Kurten for establishing his new residence. He reported that he did not. Mayor Vitulli will contact different city and county entities regarding permits.
3. March 23, 2010 City Council minutes were reviewed. Motion by Alderman Klintworth to approve minutes. Alderman Estes seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Review and approve financial report. No report this month.
5. Consider and take action on the following bills:

 - b. Mayor Vitulli was contacted by resident selling land on FM 2038 and Oak Lake. The person purchasing the land wants to establish an RV Park and wanted information on ordinances. Mayor Vitulli gave him the information.
8. Discuss mobile home on Sammy Catalena property.
 - a. Mr. Catalena is attempting to sell the mobile home. If he is not successful, he will move it himself. The City will give him the opportunity to take care of it.
9. Discuss and take action on City of Kurten sales tax.
 - a. City of Kurten sales tax proposition will be on the ballot on the May 8, 2010 election.
 - b. Early voting will take place at Bryan City Hall.
 - c. Letter sent to Kurten residents explaining what the council is doing regarding a sales tax and other news.
10. Discuss and approve Interlocal Agreement with Bryan ISD for May election. Motion by Alderman Estes to approve executing Interlocal Agreement with Bryan ISD for May election. Alderman Adams seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
11. Discussion of future agenda items.
 - a. Swear in Alderman Estes for Place 3, Alderman Adams for Place 4, and Alderman Bouse for Place 5.
