**City Council Meeting Minutes**  
**June 22, 2010**

**Regular City Council Meeting**

1. Mayor Vitulli called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Aldermen Lindahl, Adams, and Klintworth were present. Aldermen Estes and Bouse were not in attendance.
